**VOLUNTARY RESIDENTIAL PEAK DEMAND REDUCTION
PILOT PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

The undersigned, _____ (“Member”), desires to participate in a voluntary residential peak demand reduction pilot program offered by DS&O Electric Cooperative, Inc. (“DS&O”). This program involves DS&O shutting off power (“disconnect” or “disconnecting”) to Member’s meter for specific durations, on certain dates, and during certain hours and turning power back on (“reconnect” or “reconnecting”) after a disconnect event.

For this pilot program, Member understands and further agrees to the following:

- DS&O reserves the right to determine if Member is eligible to participate, based on Member’s rate class, load profile, and meter hardware.
- DS&O may disconnect Member’s meter in June 2019 to test the system. DS&O shall attempt to notify Member prior to the disconnection. Depending on the success of the test, DS&O may conduct additional tests in June. During a test, the meter may be off for up to 20 minutes before it is turned back on.
- DS&O may disconnect Member’s meter at any time between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, during the months of July and August 2019; however, DS&O shall not disconnect Member’s meter on July 4th.
- At least 20 minutes prior to a disconnect event, DS&O shall send a disconnect notice by text and/or email to the number and/or email address Member provides. DS&O shall not be responsible for any fees Member may incur for text or email notification. Also, DS&O shall not be responsible for undelivered or unread text and/or email messages.
- Member shall receive a \$50.00 bill credit on Member’s August bill, which Member receives in September. Early withdrawal from the pilot program by Member, for any reason, shall constitute Member’s automatic forfeiture of bill credit discussed in this paragraph.
- Member shall not be charged the on-peak electricity rate during July and August. All electricity shall be priced to Member at the off-peak rate. Early withdrawal from the pilot program by Member, for any reason, shall cause all Member’s electricity usage for the month of withdrawal and all future months to be priced according to the appropriate Residential – Rural (R-1) or Residential – Urban (R-2) rate.
