

Rate GS-17 General Service

Last Revised: 1-1-2011 Effective: 1-1-2017 Page: 1 of 2

This rate replaces GS-10.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to commercial, small industrial, public and three-phase farm members located in areas served by DS&O who do not qualify for service under other DS&O rate schedules.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase and three-phase where available, AC, 60 cycles, at available voltages.

RATE

Availability Charge \$50.00 per month
Energy Charge (June – September) \$.1015 per kWh
Energy Charge (all other months) \$.0915 per kWh
Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) TBD

MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

The minimum monthly bill shall be the highest of the following:

- Availability Charge; or
- A charge of \$1.00 per kVA of installed transformer nameplate capacity, if the service is three-phase.

SEASONAL SERVICE

Members requiring this service for seasonal usage shall be required to pay a monthly minimum each of the 12 months, as determined in accordance with the foregoing section.

TEMPORARY SERVICE

Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate. The member shall pay the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service, less the value of materials returned to stock. DS&O may require a deposit, in advance, of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

If the member's power factor is found by test or by power factor metering to be less than 95% lagging, then the account shall be transferred to the General Service - Demand rate schedule.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. The rated capacity of single-phase motors shall not be in excess of 10 HP, unless approved by DS&O.

2. A member with a home on the same premises as his or her business may include service to both home and business on the same meter and all service shall be billed under this rate schedule. Alternatively, the member may prefer to have service metered and billed separately for their home and business.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT (PCA)

See PCA rate schedule.

PAYMENT

Payment terms are specified in accordance with DS&O's Rules and Regulations.
